Stuart Grimley MP Office Open in Torquay

Torquay is now home to Derryn Hinch's Justice Party MP Stuart Grimley, as the doors to his office have officially opened this week

The office, centrally located at 1/15 Pearl Street, is a great opportunity for locals with State Government issues – or issues they aren't sure where to direct – to talk to someone who can assist in navigating Government departments and processes.

Mr Grimley has encouraged constituents to come and introduce themselves to him and his staff and to also get involved in their campaign to support St Vinnies' Winter Appeal throughout the month of July.

A box will be available in the foyer of their new office for locals to drop off blankets and warm linen which will be given to St Vinnies in Geelong to distribute to rough sleepers and families who are doing it tough this winter.

The official office opening will be held this Friday afternoon, with party namesake Derryn Hinch, Justice Party and Electorate Office staff, family and friends invited to celebrate Torquay's first 'local MP'.

Grimley, who was elected in November last year, represents Western Victoria; an 80,000km Electorate spanning from Horsham to the South Australian border, all the way along the South Coast and up through Melton.

The office will be open from 9am-5pm Monday to Friday.
