Geelong to Welcome Derryn Hinch to Talk Politics

Stuart Grimley MP is hosting Derryn Hinch at The Edge Geelong this Saturday for a 'Politics in the Pub' afternoon.

'The Human Headline' as he is known, will be at **The Edge (6/8 Eastern Beach Rd) from 3pm until 4.30pm** to talk to guests about his extensive journalism career, his advocacy for a child sex offender register and his time as a Senator in Australian Parliament.

Further, Derryn will be able to answer questions from attendees about the current political climate and his intentions to run as a candidate in the 2022 Federal Election.

Derryn Hinch celebrated his 60th year in journalism this month, surrounded by high profile friends and former colleagues including Peter Hitchener, Rhonda Burchmore and Tony Tardio.

His achievements as a Victorian Senator (2016-2019) included passport bans for convicted child sex offenders, Chair of the Redress Committee, but most importantly put enough pressure on the Federal Government for them to commit \$7.8m to a National Public Child Sex Offender Register.

Stuart Grimley is an Upper House MP for Western Victoria region. As an ex-police officer, SOCIT detective and school principal, he is using his background to advocate for at-risk children, to reform bail, parole and sentencing and to uphold emergency services workers' rights.
