Grimley Staying Hygienic with Hand Sanitizers

Stuart Grimley MP is handing out free hand sanitizers to businesses in his electorate to assist with keeping hygienic in the coronavirus pandemic.

The Member for Western Victoria is offering 25 pocket-size hand sanitizers to small and medium businesses in his electorate, including Horsham, Hamilton, the broader Wimmera, Portland, Warrnambool, Port Fairy, Ballarat and everywhere in between.

Mr Grimley is encouraging businesses to take up the opportunity to receive free sanitizers, with the business able to choose how it is used, such as to give to staff for personal hygiene, to have on tables in cafes/restaurants for customer use or for take away customers to take home.
