### **Calls for Inverleigh Level Crossing Upgrades**

Stuart Grimley MP has called on the State Government to provide an explanation as to why a request for a safe level crossing to be installed at the high risk Fuller Road crossing have been ignored.

In September, a serious accident occurred when a train and car collided at the notorious crossing, where installation of boom gates, lights and bells have been neglected for a simple historical stop sign.

Grimley reported that according to locals, this crossing should have been considered for upgrades by the Government five years ago.

#### **Quotes Attributable to Stuart Grimley MP:**

“Approximately 16 trains travel through the Fuller Road crossing daily, and when there’s poor weather such a fog, a stop sign isn’t sufficient.

The Terrier Road Action Committee have stated that the locals were desperate for upgrades, but there calls for help were unanswered.

How many serious accidents or deaths need to occur before the Government take action?

This level crossing needs to be upgraded as a matter of urgency.”
