

## Stuart Grimley MP Welcomes Support for Alcoa

Western Victorian MP Stuart Grimley has welcomed the federal government's announcement of support for Alcoa's smelter in Portland. The electricity supply deal has been struck today, ensuring 600 jobs will be saved for at least the next five years.

The deal energy deal struck with AGL, Alinta and Origin will provide much needed support for Alcoa and the Portland community, following discussions of an uncertain future for the operation.

Mr Grimley has raised the need for support of Alcoa a number of times to both the State and Federal Governments urging them to ensure support was offered before the July 2021 contract was due to cease.

Mr Grimley has spoken to Glenelg Shire Council a number of times about the future of Alcoa and the importance of the employer to the Portland and surrounding communities – this news is a great show of support to Victoria's regional and rural townships. He took these concerns to the State and Federal Governments and is pleased to see them come to the table.

Not only does the company create direct jobs for locals, there are many indirect jobs and industries that rely heavily on the success of Alcoa.

Mr Grimley says it is imperative that we can continue to support jobs in rural and regional Victoria.
